

Revesby Reservoir membership rules

THESE RULES COULD CHANGE DURING THE MEMBERSHIP YEAR:

1. Membership gives access to the Revesby Reservoir and Wong lake.
2. No more than six people at any one time are allowed to fish the Wong.
3. All fish caught must be returned to the same water they came from.
4. No fish can be kept in carp sacks for longer than fifteen minutes.
5. No carp are to be kept in a Keep net.
6. Ill or damaged fish must be kept in a sack and reported immediately to the Estate office.
7. Any dead fish must be reported to the Estate Office.
8. No barbed or bent hooks are permitted (except micro barbs)
9. No fixed leads are permitted.
10. Any tethered or broken lines must be reported to the Estate Office.
11. Main lines must be a minimum of 12lbs breaking strain.
12. No Peanuts or Tiger nuts are permitted.
13. All other particles have to be precooked and soaked.
14. Each angler may only use three rods.
15. Rod licence and membership card must be carried at all times.
16. Dogs, firearms and bank side fires are all NOT permitted.
17. Cars are not to go beyond and must stay in the Car Park.
18. Car parking is at owner's risk.
19. Responsibility is not accepted for accident or injury or damage to your own personal property on Revesby Estate.
20. It is your responsibility to confirm other fishermen on the lake are also members.
21. All unhooking mats and nets must be dipped in a Revesby disinfections tank.
22. Bait boats are not permitted.
23. Members are only allowed to Fish in one swim at a time.
24. Revesby Estate reserves the right to inspect your tackle or car at anytime as part of regular security checks on the lake.
25. Communication will mainly be made through email.
26. Can all members please report their catches to the email provided.
27. Revesby Estate reserves the right to temporally close the lake with no prior warning.
28. We ask members not to fish on Christmas day and therefore consider the lake to be closed.
29. Night fishing is allowed for no more than five consecutive nights, and then there must be a two night break before staying overnight again.
30. No night fishing allowed in December and January due to shooting activities for health and safety reasons unless agreed with the owner.
31. Bivvies, rods and other equipment cannot be left unattended for long periods of the day or night just to reserve the position while you are not at your peg/swim.
32. Tackle must be withdrawn from the water when unattended.
33. Litter in the vicinity of his or her peg is considered his or her responsibility.
34. All members must take their rubbish home with them.
35. The gates are locked at the end of the designated opening hours, and once locked you must stay the night. The gates will not be opened unless in a proven emergency.
36. By paying your membership you are hereby accepting all of the above.
37. Membership is non transferable. The Estate allows partners to spectate with members, at our discretion.
38. Noise and lights must be kept to a minimum at all times.
39. Members are only allowed to fish at night with prior permission.

All members must use an unhooking mat.

The Reservoir/Wong are not to be used as a non member social gathering venue.

Finally the lake is there for your enjoyment and we endeavour to make it possible for all members to have equal access to the whole lake so please respect other members.
